Directions from show site: Turn Right on Oakcrest Dr./Algonquin Road for 4.7 miles, then turn left on Randall Road for 4.4 miles (road name changes to James Rakow Road). Turn right on Pingree Road. Vet is in a strip mall on the left at the corner of Rakow and Pingree.

### **Handler Discrimination Element**

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag. For the Novice A/B class, one cotton glove or sock. For Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class. Handlers may utilize any method they feel is best to scent their article. Suggestions include rubbing the article on the handler's body or storing the item in dirty laundry.

### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

**Condition of the Dog.** Dogs with physical challenges (including

amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Rachael Alspach at [alspachrachael@gmail.com](mailto:alspachrachael@gmail.com). No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class. Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run AKC recording fee.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

### **Waitlist Information**

CDA will maintain a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to February 24<sup>th</sup>, at 8 PM. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial will

receive a full refund. All entries not given space in the trial will be shredded.

### **Refunds**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

**Bitches in season & Injured dogs** - entries shall be refunded less \$5.00 for bitches that come in season after the closing, no vet note required. Dogs that are injured will be refunded their entry less \$5.00 with proof from their veterinarian. The Trial secretary needs to be informed by 8:00 A.M. the day of the trial.

### **Additional Site Information**

**It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.**

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

**PLEASE Pick Up after your dog.  
Anyone caught not picking up will be asked  
to leave without refund of entries.**

We know that some of your dogs are very exuberant and cannot help but bark. For those that are not able to prevent your dogs from barking, please park on the south side of the building.

Please do not walk your dogs along the fence on the west side of the drainage area. There is a lot of area to walk on the east side of the drainage area and along the south side of the buildings.

Please do not park in parking spots right in front of the gymnastic club or ANY of the businesses in the complex.

No lunch for sale for handlers.

Briefings will be done in view of the search area by the judge.

We may use Facebook/Agility Gate/Google Sheets if necessary to keep the trial flowing; please read your final confirmation for more details.

All crating will be done in vehicles. No indoor crating except for volunteers and judges.

### **Ribbons, Awards, and Prizes**

Placement rosettes will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue  
Second Place.....Red  
Third Place.....Yellow  
Fourth Place.....White

A Dark Green ribbon will be awarded for each qualifying score.

A New Title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

No ribbons will be mailed to exhibitors.

High in Trial and High Combined will be offered.

### **Safety**

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, dog, and/or children that create an unnecessary disturbance, or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall

have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
