RETURNED CHECKS does not constitute a valid entry fee.

BITCHES IN SEASON Any bitch that comes into season after the closing date may have their entry fee returned, less \$5.00 per entry administrative fee without any veterinarian documentation. Any dog injured after closing date may have entry fee returned, less \$5.00 per entry by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins.
